What shape does Tom's sister cut the cookie dough into?



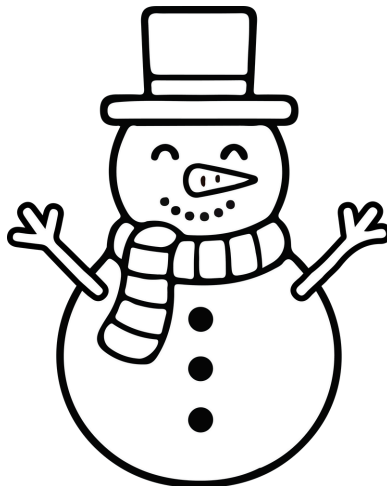
The magic snowman
